



MY PASSION IN PIXELS

45 Mins - 1 hour long Powerpoint Presentation

PIXEL QUILT WORKSHOP

2 Methods to creating pixel quilts (sewing workshop)

4 - 7 hour workshop

- An introduction to sewing pixel quilts using 2 techniques.
- Participants will be taught both techniques whilst putting together a pixel cherry blossom enabling them to distinguish which method they prefer before attempting their own pixel quilt.
- 4 Hour workshop covers cutting the fabric, piecing in both ways to make usually between 1-3 blocks
- 7 Hour workshop enables participants to piece more blocks and the longer workshop can help facilitate participants working one on one with Dee for 30 minutes, to create their own pixel quilt pattern at an additional cost of \$25 per person (usually \$85)

QUILT DRESS DESIGN WORKSHOP

Turning A Quilt Top into a Dress

4 Hours

- Participants create the dress out of cheap fabrics whilst I
 will cut a quilt top to demonstrate everything they need to
 take into consideration before cutting into a quilt
 themselves
- Breaking down the pattern into more easily readable terms
- Cutting the fabric and labelling all notches/dots
- Sewing the dress together, including adding pockets and altering the neck if participants don't want the scarf neckline
- Fundamentals that participants need to know before ever cutting into a quilt top
- Where to find quilt tops to buy if you don't want to make your own
- Participants will be required to buy pattern in advance and cut out correct sized pieces
- Participants will be send PDF of all points covered in the class after it it finished
